Code of Conduct for Volunteers

Our mission statement:

With this in mind the following code of conduct has been agreed for all volunteers taking part in The Friends of Stanley Grove activities, to ensure a professional, high quality and consistent delivery is maintained:

- All Friends of Stanley Grove should promote the idea of inclusiveness – both for pupils and parents/carers at events and for anyone wishing to volunteer.
- Good communication should be maintained throughout. This includes using the appropriate method of communication to ensure relevant parties are kept up to date – including Whatsapp, Facebook, the FOSG space on the school website and when verbally dealing with other volunteers, school or pupils/parents/carers when giving instruction at events.
- Friends of Stanley Grove are all responsible for ensuring resources and equipment are set up and tidied away in a timely and adequate manor, in liaison with event lead, to ensure good relations are maintained with staff.
- Friends of Stanley Grove should always seek value for money when sourcing equipment and resources.
- Friends of Stanley Grove should act professionally, responsibly and welcoming at all times, at events, meetings, dealings with school or when promoting Friends of Stanley Grove activities to other parents/carers.
- Friends of Stanley Grove should be mindful of safeguarding and speak to a member of staff if they have any concerns or questions regarding this matter.
- Friends of Stanley Grove should actively promote the group and events whenever possible to maximise attendance, effectiveness and volunteer interest.
