Summer Topic (Half Term 6): Ancient Egypt

Ancient Egypt was a civilization of ancient North Africa, concentrated along the lower reaches of the Nile River in the place that is now the country Egypt.

Subjects I will cover in this topic:

Things I will learn during this topic:

- I will learn about chronology and use historical vocabulary to describe the period studied and create timeline of events.
- I will learn when and where the Ancient Egyptians came from.
- I will use maps to locate key places and geographical features of Egypt.
- I will study who Howard Carter was and the significance of his discoveries.
- I will learn who Tutenkhamun was.
- I will learn about key aspects of Ancient Egyptian life including for example, food, clothes, religion, the structure of their society and houses.
- I will learn about the process of mummification and its links to beliefs about the afterlife.
- I will be able to use my maths skills to solve problems about aspects of the pyramids and their numbering system.
- I will try to empathise with people who lived throughout this time period and understand what life would have been like.
- I will use a variety of historical sources to find out about this time period including conducting research using various websites, Powerpoints, videos and podcasts.
- I will use my research to create PowerPoints about the Ancient Egyptian time period; write information reports and diary entries in Literacy.
- An overview of where and when the first civilisations appeared in Ancient Egypt.
- Ancient Egyptian Art, cartouches and hieroglyphs, and ideas for decoration drawn from Ancient Egyptian art.

Tutankhamun



Tutankhamun was an Egyptian pharaoh of the 18th dynasty during the period of Egyptian history known as the New Kingdom.

Howard Carter

A British archaeologist and Egyptologist who became world-famous after discovering the intact tomb of the 18th Dynasty Pharaoh, Tutankhamun (colloquially known as "King Tut" and "the boy king"), in November 1922.
