- Make sure that you use the parental controls and settings menu to stop your child accessing inappropriate information. My friends at Internet Matters (http://www.internetmatters.org/) have lots of useful tips, especially with changing the settings on these devices.
- Set up the account for the device in your name, so you can see what your child is downloading.
- Make sure that when setting up an account on certain Apps, you make sure they are
 old enough to use it. Many of them such as Snapchat and Facebook have restrictions
 which mean you have to be 13 to use them.
- Whilst I know they will be excited to get these new presents, discuss with them the importance of having a balance and incorporate 'non-screen time'.
- Video games have an age classification. Many of the most popular games are rated '16' or '18' which means that you have to be this age to play them as they contain bad language, violence and inappropriate content. - Make sure that you talk to your children about being online. If they are worried about something they see online, look at ways that you can prevent it repeating.
