








Ways to learn spellings.

<p>Pyramid words Write your words in a pyramid.</p> 	<p>Scribble words. Write your words in a scribble.</p> 	<p>Stripy Words Write all the vowels in one colour and the consonants in another. chocolate</p>	<p>Rainbow words Write each letter with a different colour... make it pretty!</p> 
<p>Words within words. Write your word and find a word within the word...write in a different colour.</p>	<p>Three times Write each word in pencil, then in pen, then in coloured pencil or another type of pen. pencil pencil pencil</p>	<p>Waterfall words Write your word like a waterfall w wa wat water</p>	<p>Words without vowels. Write all your words without vowels. Put a line where the vowel should go. Then try and remember which vowel goes where! ch-c-l-t-</p>
<p>Draw your word Draw a picture to illustrate your word.</p> 	<p>Choo choo words Write your list as one long word. write each word in a different colour. waterfallcolourchocolate</p>	<p>Partner swap Each person says alternate letters in the word. The winner doesn't make a mistake!</p>	<p>Draw around the word Draw around the word to make the shape, one letter in each box. Now try and write the word again – matching the shape.</p> 
<p>Spiral words Write your word in a spiral, starting in the middle and working outwards.</p> 	<p>Mnemonic Make a silly phrase using the letters big elephants can always use small ears. because</p>	<p>Across and down Write your spellings across and down. Try and join as many as possible</p> 	<p>Spelling shapes. Draw a different shape for each spelling...then try and fit the word in exactly!</p>
