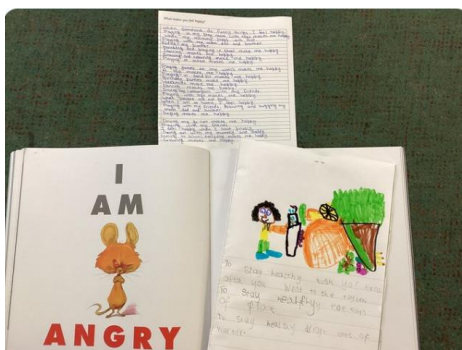


## Know your religion Day
