- As Geographers, we will understand deforestation's impact on the environment and settlements.
- As Artists, we will create portraits using hatching, line, tone, value to create the illusion of depth.
- As Scientists, we will study properties and changes of materials.
- As Designers, use textiles to create a tablet case;
