Things I will learn during this topic:

- As Historians and writers, we will find out about different areas of the Ancient Maya Civilisation;
- As Artists, we will observe and attempt replicate or recreate the works of Frederick Catherwood;
- As Artists, we will create a weaving loom (a technique used in Ancient Maya culture);
- As Historians, we will compare and contrast similarities between social class systems in Maya times to modern day;
- As Historians and Mathematicians, we will outline the chronology of Maya history, using a timeline;
- As Historians, we will recreate our own versions of a Maya City State;
- As Writers, we will create a short diary entry about life in a Maya town;
- As Historical Writers, we will create a newspaper article about the 'Mysterious Disappearance of the Maya';
- As Historians, we will analyse and learn about the difference between primary and secondary sources;
- As Geographers, we will use maps to analyse Maya territory;
- As Geographers, we will use four and six figure grid references that refer to Maya land;
- As Historians and Mathematicians, we will use Ancient Mayan Hieroglyphs to solve Maths puzzles.

Things that will help me learn and exciting things that will happen:

- I will create a weaving loom;
- I will design an Ancient Maya City State, using knowledge learnt in Topic sessions;
- I will learn and use Ancient Maya Hieroglyphs for Mathematical purposes;
- I will recreate my own version of the artwork of Frederick Catherwood.


