##### Anglo-Saxons:

- As Historians, take on the role of an archaeologists, analysing Anglo-Saxon artefacts to see how artefacts can give clues in history
- As Historians, study Anglo-Saxon village life: to create an detailed and labelled illustration of an Anglo-Saxon Village
- As Historical Writers, create an information leaflet about an area of Anglo-Saxon life, including their influence on religion
- As Historians and Geographers, study the invasion of the Anglo-Saxons in Britain
- As Historians and Geographers, analyse Anglo-Saxon influences on British religion and towns, including road and street names
- As Historians and Geographers, use maps to prove that Anglo-Saxons invaded areas of Britain (looking for Anglo-Saxon influences)
- As Writers, create poetry, narrative, adventurous and descriptive writing, inspired by the mythical text 'Beowulf'
- As Artists and Designers, create handcrafted wire sculptures relating to Anglo-Saxon life.
- As Artists and Designers, create collage.

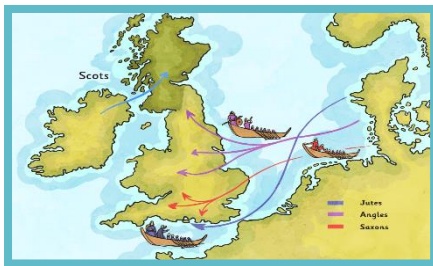
#### Things that will help me learn and exciting things that will happen:
