

Dear Parents and Carers,

A very warm welcome to Class 3. We are really looking forward to teaching the children this year and to meeting you all in due course. Attached to this letter you will find the topic organiser outlining the work we will be doing this half term. As you can see, our Topic is 'Local Hero' plus 'Wakefield and Scarborough', and any books/resources you may have at home connected to this would be gratefully received. We also attach an overview for the year. Do note that this is a guide only!

Here are some bits of information you might find useful...

- Class 3 start time is 8.35am. We come in through the double doors at the back of the school. We dismiss at 2.35pm from the same doors. Please line up outside Class 2 so that we can dismiss the children to you.
- We will give children pens/pencils etc., so they do not need to bring in items like this from home.
- **Homework** will be given out on **Friday** and should be completed and returned to school the following **Wednesday**. Look out for a yellow book with the homework sheet and spelling sheet etc. stuck in. It will usually consist of 10-15 spellings to learn, times tables to learn, a piece of maths and/or a piece of English (which may or may not be connected to the topic). Look out for reminders/extra information on the homework sheet each week. Sometimes homework is given over a 2-week period. We will always make this clear on the homework sheet. On the inside cover of the homework book you will find the log-in details for TTRockstars, which children should spend 10-15 mins on per week at home as part of their homework.
- **PE** will be on **Monday** and **Friday**. Kits should be worn to school on those days. See homework sheet Week 1 for full details. Outdoor Learning will **probably** be on a **Tuesday (just need to finalise this)**. Please send your child in their outdoor PE kit on this day **AND** send a pair of wellies in a named carrier bag which can remain in school if possible.
- **Reading books** should go home every night. When your child has completed the book please sign the reading record. Please do feel free to comment in the reading record book should you need to. Our Teaching Assistant will change books put into the box in the classroom every **Tuesday** and **Thursday**.
- Please use MyEd for any monies which need to come into school for any reason (trips, clubs etc).

If you have any queries, questions or feedback, please do not hesitate to come and see us, or use the feedback box on the homework sheet. Finally, we always welcome help in the classroom, so do please let us know if you would like to join us for whatever time you can spare.
